Project Spotlights

- ★ First Solar plans to invest \$1.1 billion to establish a photovoltaic (PV) solar module manufacturing facility in Lawrence County, which is expected to create over 700 new jobs.
- ★ Hyundai is investing \$300 million and hiring an expected 200 workers to begin producing its first North American electric vehicles out of its Montgomery plant.
- ★ The Department of Transportation awarded \$21.7 million to the City of Birmingham to redevelop approximately 2.5 miles of road with a complete streets approach, including a two-way cycle track, improved ADA access, sidewalks, and other universal design elements.
- ★ The City of Atmore was awarded \$19 million for the Pine Barren Watershed project to reduce the impact of flooding in the area.

Infrastructure

\$6.5 billion in Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding has been announced to Alabama for **345 projects**, including:

- **\$4 billion** for transportation, including \$3.2 billion for roads and bridges, \$224.3 million for public transit, \$109.5 million for airports, \$100.4 million for ports and waterways.
- \$1.7 billion for high-speed internet since President Biden took office.
- \$450.4 million for clean water, including \$133.5 million to replace toxic lead pipes.

Clean Energy and Climate

Under the Biden-Harris Administration, private companies have announced **\$4.6 billion** in commitments to invest in clean energy industries, including:

- \$1.7 billion in clean power projects, including solar, wind, and batteries with enough energy to power an estimated 187,000 homes.
- \$1.3 billion for clean energy manufacturing.
- \$1.5B in battery and electric vehicle manufacturing.

\$413.5 million in public funding has been announced for grants, rebates, and other initiatives to accelerate the deployment of clean energy, clean buildings, and clean manufacturing. This is not inclusive of the clean energy tax incentives from the Inflation Reduction Act.

\$101.7 million for clean transportation, including \$45.5 million for EV chargers, \$29.7 million for clean transit buses, and \$26.5 million for clean school buses.

Lowering Costs

- \$145.6 million in home energy rebates to cut energy costs by weatherizing homes and replacing old appliances with more efficient models.
- 1.1 million seniors and other Medicare beneficiaries will save money on prescription drug costs because of President Biden's \$2,000 yearly cap on out-of-pocket prescription drug costs, a \$35 monthly cap per insulin prescription, free vaccines, inflation rebates, and a drug price negotiation program.
- **386K individuals** in Alabama signed up for health insurance through the Affordable Care Act Marketplaces during the Open Enrollment Period for 2024 and will benefit from average savings of about \$800/year from lower health care premiums.
- \$2 billion in student debt cancellation has been approved for 37.2K people in Alabama under the Biden-Harris Administration.
