Project Spotlights

- ★ Novozymes committed to building a \$316 million investment in Blair, Nebraska to produce innovative plant-based protein products.
- ★ Sustainable Beef LLC recently broke ground at a \$325 million beef processing facility in North Platte. Once operational, the plant is projected to create 875 jobs.
- ★ The U.S. Department of Transportation awarded \$23.6 million to construct the Lincoln Multimodal Transit Center. The new sustainable transit center will include bus bays, protected passenger boarding, covered walkways, and more, all of which will improve the safety and security of passengers and pedestrians.
- ★ The Eppley Airfield in Omaha was awarded \$30 million for a new terminal dropoff area and full canopy to reduce air pollution and improve access for passengers with disabilities.

Infrastructure

\$2.7 billion in Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding has been announced to Nebraska for **387 projects**, including:

- \$1.7 billion for transportation, including \$1.3 billion for roads and bridges, \$101.5 million for public transit, \$106.4 million for airports, \$5.2 million for ports and waterways.
- \$509.4 million for high-speed internet since President Biden took office.
- \$251 million for clean water, including \$85.7 million to replace toxic lead pipes.

Clean Energy and Climate

Under the Biden-Harris Administration, private companies have announced **\$113.1 million** in clean power projects, including solar, wind, and batteries with enough energy to power an estimated **18,000 homes.**

\$233.4 million in public funding has been announced for grants, rebates, and other initiatives to accelerate the deployment of clean energy, clean buildings, and clean manufacturing. This is not inclusive of the clean energy tax incentives from the Inflation Reduction Act.

\$19.6 million for clean transportation, including \$17.3 million for EV chargers, and \$2.3 million for clean school buses.

Lowering Costs

- \$91.4 million in home energy rebates to cut energy costs by weatherizing homes and replacing old appliances with more efficient models.
- 378K seniors and other Medicare beneficiaries will save money on prescription drug costs because of President Biden's \$2,000 yearly cap on out-of-pocket prescription drug costs, a \$35 monthly cap per insulin prescription, free vaccines, inflation rebates, and a drug price negotiation program.
- 118K individuals in Nebraska signed up for health insurance through the Affordable Care Act Marketplaces during the Open Enrollment Period for 2024 and will benefit from average savings of about \$800/year from lower health care premiums.
- \$742.8 million in student debt cancellation has been approved for 15.3K people in Nebraska under the Biden-Harris Administration.
