Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Combating Emerging Firearms Threats and Improving School-Based Active-Shooter Drills"

This executive order would establish an Emergency Firearms Threats Task Force and would direct agencies to publish information to help improve schools' active-shooter drills. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include developing strategies to reduce the threat of machinegun conversion devices and 3D printed firearms, and to help make active-shooter drills more effective, age and developmentally appropriate, and less traumatic for students. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2024. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include the Departments of Commerce, Education; Health and Human Services, Homeland Security, Justice, and State.
